Camping

Leelanau State Park

Entrance fee for a **non Michigan Resident** is \$9.00 per day per vehicle or \$32.00 annual pass, per vehicle.

Lighthouse Keeper Program

Here's your chance to be a lighthouse keeper. The Grand Traverse Lighthouse Museum has a program where you stay at the lighthouse for one or two weeks. There will be two couples or four people staying at the facility, depending on the schedule and room availability. You'll work several hours a day conducting tours as a lighthouse docent. You also help with maintenance and repairs. It's typically an eight hour day and you'll have time off during your stay. For this privilege, you'll pay \$150 per week and must apply in advance.

There are few lighthouses that have Keeper programs which offer the participants an opportunity to live for a week or two in an historic lighthouse. Working as a Keeper is a very rewarding and learning experience - it is not a vacation of "R & R". Keepers can, however, thoroughly enjoy the time they spend here making new friends, learning new things, and having lots of fun with the experience of "Keeping a Lighthouse". The view, the sunsets from the tower and the atmosphere are unforgettable, as well as the hiking trails and the many attractions of the region.
