

# **Biking, Hiking, or Birding at The Leelanau Conservancy Areas—In/Near Northport**

## **1. Finton Natural Area**

**Short Easy Hike—35 Acres**

From Northport, take M-201 north. Turn right on Northport Point Rd (CR 640). Drive 0.5 mile. Entrance is on the left, across from Paradesia Road, before sign.

## **2. Houdek Dunes Natural Area**

**Moderate Hike---330 Acres**

**3/4 & 1-1/2 mile loops; Sand, Stairs & Slopes; Benches at Ancient Maple**

From Northport, drive six miles south, on M-22 west toward Leland. A sign on the right side of the road marks the entrance to parking.

## **3. Kehl Lake Natural Area**

**Easy Hike ---227 Acres**

**Three Loops of Varying Lengths**

From Northport, take M-201 north, which changes to CR 640/Woolsey Lake Road. After two miles, turn left on Snyder Road. After 0.5 mile, turn right on Sugarbush Road. Drive 0.7 miles to the corner of Kehl and Ottis; go straight on Kehl for 0.2 miles. The sign and parking are on the left.

## **4. Lighthouse West Natural Area**

**45 Acres**

**3/4 mile flat, easy trail; 800 feet rigorous trail-steep bluff to Lake Michigan**

From Northport, take M-201 north, toward the lighthouse, for approximately 8 miles. M-201 changes to CR 640/Woolsey Lake Road, then to CR 629/Woolsey Lake Road. Turn left on Cathead Bay Drive. Sign and parking are on the right.

## **5. Jeff Lamont Preserve**

**40 Acres**

From Northport, take M-201 north, which changes to CR 640. Take CR 640 0.3 miles. Turn left at North Kilcherman (antique apple farm with windmill.) Go 1 mile. The road curves to the left and becomes Christmas Cove Road. Take Christmas Cove Road 0.5 miles and stay right as you pass Scott Road. The Preserve is 0.15 miles down the hill, on the right. Park near the sign.
